**DAY 1 – THURSDAY, JULY 2** – We begin our America's 250<sup>th</sup> Birthday Adventure this morning as we all meet at the Jackson Evers Airport at 3:30AM to get checked in and hand out our boarding passes, for our 5:10AM departure to Washington, DC. We will arrive at Reagan National Airport on Southwest Airlines at 12:20PM and will be picked up by our private motorcoach. After collecting our luggage, we will depart the airport and make the short drive to our Nation's Capitol, Washington, DC – a grand and stately city of imposing national shrines and monuments that testify to some of America's greatest names. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, an impressive building dedicated to showcasing and preserving the Arts from around our Country. We will be able to enjoy a live performance at the Millennium Stage, then tour this beautiful building at our own pace. Following our time there, we will transfer to our hotel, for group check in and time to unpack and relax. To make this evening convenient, we will enjoy freshly made Pizza and salad catered by one of Washington's favorite local restaurants, which is included in our tour this evening. This will be a great beginning to our trip. After dinner at your leisure, we will enjoy our hotel for a restful evening. (D)

**DAY 2 – FRIDAY, JULY 3** – We will enjoy a deluxe breakfast included at our hotel. We have an exciting day planned, as we will have a licensed DC guide with us throughout the day for our guided tour! We will start with a special visit to our Nation's most sacred shrine – Arlington National Cemetery, to see the Changing of the Guard ceremony, and to visit the graves of Robert and John F. Kennedy. We will tour Arlington on a guided tram tour. We will also be able to see Audie Murphy and Medgar Evers's graves. Following Arlington, we will transfer to the U.S. Capitol Welcome Center, where we will break for lunch, on our own, at the Capitol Visitor's Center Food Court. Following lunch, we will meet one of the "Red Coat" Captiol Tour Guides to experience a guided tour of the Captiol and Statuary Hall. Next, we will journey to the 1860's as we have a guided tour of Ford's Theatre, where President Abraham Lincoln was assassinated by John Wilkes Booth. There is an impressive museum at Ford's that will take us through the Civil War, slavery, and Reconstruction. Following our time at Ford's Theatre, we will see the White House, home our President, and learn about its history, and time for a group photo on the north side. After our time here, we will transfer to Old Town Alexandria, Virginia, where we will be welcomed by a costumed guide, for a fun and unique history tour, with some spooky stories mixed in. We will see where George Washington worshipped and where his Inaugural Ball was held. We will end our day with everyone enjoying dinner at your choice of great restaurants along King Street, on your own this evening. There are so many great restaurants and neat shops to explore! We will return to our hotel following our time in Old Town this evening. (B)

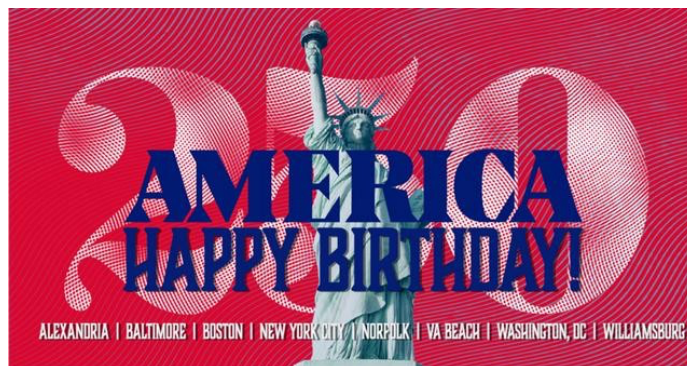
**DAY 3 – SATURDAY, JULY 4** – **Happy Independence Day!** Our group will enjoy breakfast included at our hotel this morning. At 8:15AM we will board our motocoach and transfer to the tidal basin – where the Potomac River basin surrounds the Thomas Jefferson, Franklin Roosevelt and Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Memorials. Our group will meet our step on guide to enjoy a morning tour of these monuments and memorials today. But our first stop – to honor our Veterans on our nation's birthday, will be our National World War II Memorial, where we will lay a memorial wreath at our Mississippi marker. If we are fortunate, we may get to thank a member of our "Greatest Generation" for the sacrifices they made for us. After our tour of the Memorials, we will enjoy a catered sandwich lunch from our friends at Firehouse Subs, to eat overlooking the tidal basin. After our lunch, we will make our way towards Constitution Avenue to enjoy the annual National Independence Day Parade, featuring beautiful floats, marching bands, military units, and plenty of celebration as we honor our Independence together! After a great time to celebrate, we will make the short drive back to our hotel for some time to freshen up and hydrate. This will be a great time to put on your customized T-Shirt to wear, before we make our way back to the U.S. Capitol. We will also enjoy a mouthwatering Barbeque Buffet catered by the best BBQ in DC, Rocklands Barbeque, all included at our hotel this evening! After our meal, we will unload at Union Station and make the walk to the Capitol to reserve our place for "A Capitol 4<sup>th</sup>" as we enjoy the National Symphony Orchestra which is carried nationwide on PBS. The Greatest Birthday Celebration in America will take place before our eyes as we see great family entertainment, singing, dancing and several opportunities to honor our Military Veterans and Active-Duty Servicemen and Women. Over the years, a parade of Stars have performed here like: Ray Charles, The Beach Boys, The Temptations, Dolly Parton, Huey Lewis and the News – so there will be an amazing lineup for this year's 250<sup>th</sup>! (\*We will have a complete lineup as we get closer to our departure date.) As we approach

S8:00, the United States Army Band and the U.S. Army Herald Trumpets will begin playing their patriotic medleys and marches, and the moment we have all been waiting for will begin -- a dazzling display of the largest and most beautiful fireworks in America along the DC skyline, behind the Washington Monument! Enjoy the best view in the City as we enjoy a truly unforgettable evening of music, patriotism, honor and talent as we celebrate America together. After the performance, we will load onto our motorcoach and make the short drive back to our hotel for the night. (B,L,D)

**DAY 4 – SUNDAY, JULY 5** – Our group will enjoy breakfast included at our hotel this morning. Today, we will make the short transfer to Mt. Vernon, the historic home of George and Martha Washington. We will have a tour of the mansion and enjoy the many artifacts at the Reynolds Museum. We will have lunch on our own at the food court located there. Following Mt. Vernon, we will transfer back to the National Mall to enjoy your choice of any of the world-famous Smithsonian Institute Museums. Our bus will be happy to drop you off at your choice of Smithsonian – from American History and Natural History, or the Smithsonian of American Art, African American History and the American Indian -- there is something for everyone to explore! Enjoy touring at your leisure today. For those that would like, we can also drop by the National Archives to see our Charter Documents of Freedom – our U.S. Constitution and the Declaration of Independence. After another exciting afternoon of bringing history to life, we will make a stop downtown to enjoy a local favorite restaurant for dinner, on our own this evening.
